New Equipment in Town Council managed parks



Monthly community litter picks have been organised by the Community Safety Working Group, who also worked in partnership to hold Youth Bus Sessions in October. Visit our website to find out more about the working group, and watch this space for next years litter pick dates.

Improvements have been made to Shortbank Recreation Ground, Middletown Recreation Ground, Lytham Close Play area and Broughton Road Playa area during 2024 with the installation of new equipment following our Park Strategy Consultation. Our Estates Team also continue to work on improving the Council's environmental credentials, coming pesticide free in 2024 and continuing work to provide habitats for wildlife, and plant wildflowers on the Council's Estate.







The Town Council held a number of events in 2024 including an Easter Event, Park Funs days, SnapShot Festival, Christmas Light Switch On and Christmas Market. It also worked in partnership with other organisations to hold Remembrance Sunday, Sandylands Community Day and the Great Santa Fun Run.
