The tenant of these plots has relinquished them and an offer from the pest control contractor had been submitted to take over one of the plots and remove the sheds from the other plot and return the plot to an allotment garden for re letting. The tenant does not live in Skipton, but his business is in Skipton and his family live in Skipton. Councillor C Nash confirmed that to stand in the local election for Town Council you can be eligible for running a business in the town therefore this was a strong enough link for this gentleman to become a tenant of the allotment plot.

Councillor Shaw asked if we would replace the shed on plot 65 that had been inherited and had been identified as asbestos. Councillor Nash wasn't sure if this was permissible and if free plot in compensation instead. The Clerk confirmed she would check.
