2021/016 ITEM 7 – Skipton Guide App

Mr O Wright of the Skipton Guide app presented the app that was due to be launched over the next few weeks. Councillor Madeley advised that this was an excellent app to use moving forward and Councillor Solloway asked if it was currently live. It was confirmed it wasn't and would be launched very soon. Councillor McIntyre advised it was really modern, very user friendly and an excellent initiative. It was confirmed that this would not be a replacement for the Town guide which was previously organised and funded by the Chamber of Trade and Skipton BID.

2021/018 ITEM 9 – Future Events

Discussions were held as to what events could potentially be arranged for this year. The idea of a family Sunday market with entertainers and activities.

Councillor Madeley advised that HAZ had been to the Market committee meeting and presented a proposal regarding what support could be given in conjunction with the town council but that it was very important to maintain a road closure for the high street.

Councillor Barrett agreed with the idea but asked if we could continue the idea of a busk stop for buskers to book their slots through the day and also look into large chess, drafts games etc to be provided.

Councillor McIntyre asked if we could have a gazebo for community groups to help them recover after the year of lockdown.

Councillor Heseltine advised that permission would need to be sought for a Sunday market to be held.

Councillor Solloway advised that he always thought Events committee and Market committee should work more together.

Councillor Feather wanted to support the request for the purchase of 2 gazebos for use.

It was concluded that the Clerk would gather further information to hold a special one-off Sunday market post covid recovery event and would investigate the need for the license to trade from the Charter and would report back to the next meeting.

The Clerk confirmed that the Christmas lights event would be held on Sunday 28th November, after the Santa fun run. The Thwaite horses had been secured for the event as well as a Father Christmas and the CEO of Welcome to Yorkshire.
