We have just taken part in Love Your Local Market 2023



Furthermore, artwork designed by one of our traders, was used to help introduce our traders to members of the public and highlight their businesses online.








Monday incentive scheme

We have had a fantastic response from the Monday incentive scheme, offering new traders a free pitch on a Monday for 8 weeks, allowing them to establish themselves and generate some income.

We can provide gazebos, weights and tables to new traders who have very much appreciated this service, thanks to Haz funding. This has enabled new traders to stand on the Market without the cost being too overwhelming.

We have several traders who have then gone on to also trade on other days of the week and who have become permanent traders on the market. One of our traders, Sweet Mama Bakes, started off on the Monday incentive scheme and is now trading 3 days on the market and has also opened a shop within the town.

We will continue to offer the Mondays to new trader applications and advertise the scheme through our media channels.



Coaches

We have updated the current information with regards to coach bookings and emailed this out to over 200 coach companies. There are 12 coach parking bays in the Town Hall Car park, offering bays with disabled access. We as the Town Council, currently manage 3 of these bays on market days. Since April 1st, we have had 19 bookings and are seeing the increase of enquiries since sending out the updated coach information, over the coming months, we will continue to offer a meet and great from the market officer on arrival.



Trader Vans parking on the setts

Following on from our meeting with Andrew Clare.

We are now able to issue permits daily, to traders who can park their vehicle within their pitch and behind the yellow line. Which has enabled Harrogate parking enforcement to distinguish which vehicles belong to a market trader's who have been authorised parking from the market authority. This has proven to be a successful outcome and we will continue to work closely with Harrogate to monitor the situation.

Skipton Young Trader Market.

Traders:

We have 32 traders who applied to trade on the market. The deadline was closed at 5pm on Friday 5th May 2023. Due to the size of the venue, we can only take 24 stalls (Maximum)

SYTM is the youth trader market that has received more applications than any other young trader market in the country.

Traders consist of businesses from Skipton and the surrounding area.

Stalls consist of loaded fries, brownies and cakes, honey and bee wax goods, handmade art and jewellery, resin goods, plus various other stalls.

Entertainment:

This will consist of 4 singers/ buskers of the same age group to perform live at the canal basin.

All are local to Skipton.

Each are paid £25 to perform and allowed to busk as well.

Marketing:

I have designed various posters and advertising materials which have been distributed via social media, radio interviews, and posters placed in businesses around town.

The radio interviews were done with Drystone Radio and Rombles Radio.

A Facebook Ad was run to help gain greater traction to the event.

I've also been working with Craven College and Upper Wharfdale to help get the students there involved.
